Overview

Cerebral Palsy Alliance (CPA) provides life changing support and services for people living with cerebral palsy and related conditions. With over 2,500 employees and annual revenue of approximately 240 million dollars, CPA operates at significant scale with complex financial workflows across multiple cost centres.

To better manage its growing invoice volume and lack of visibility over invoice status, CPA partnered with Efficiency Leaders to implement RapidP2P. The result is a more efficient, transparent and compliant accounts payable process that benefits both finance staff and managers across the organisation.

Opportunity

CPA's previous accounts payable process relied heavily on email and manual handoffs. Invoices were sent directly to managers, who coded and approved them before passing them on to the finance team. This lack of visibility made it difficult for accounts payable to track invoice status, follow up in time or ensure timely payments.

The organisation needed a solution that would simplify invoice handling for business managers, provide real-time oversight to the finance team and bring consistency to processes across cost centres.

"RapidP2P has made the whole process so much easier for our business managers. They just open their email, click a link, review the invoice and submit. The feedback has been overwhelmingly positive."

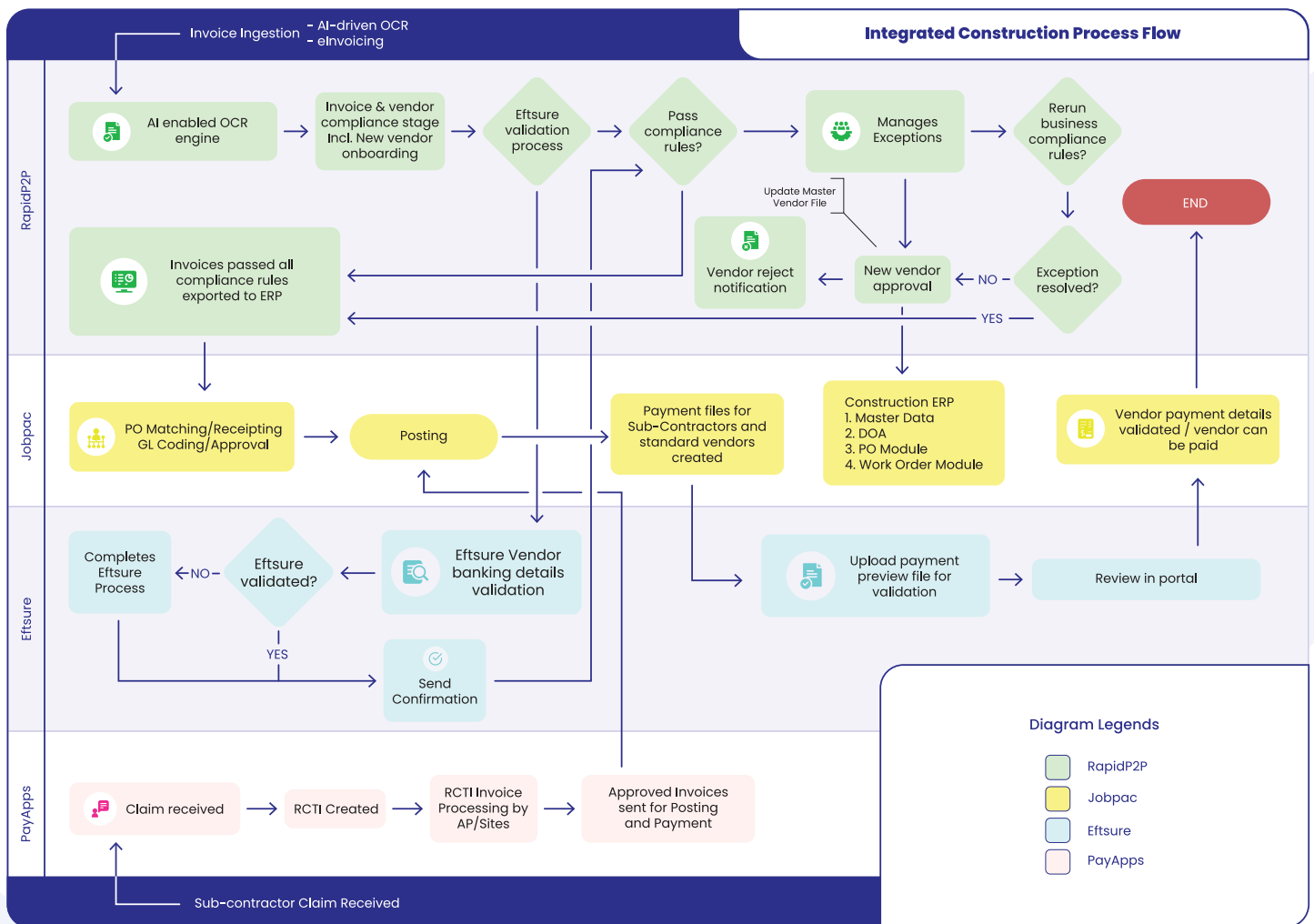

Solution

CPA deployed RapidAP as part of its RapidP2P rollout, transforming its accounts payable process with automation, compliance and visibility at the centre. Invoices now enter the system through a single channel and are instantly visible to the accounts team. The system tracks every stage, flags any issues and allows business managers to approve with just a few clicks.

Vendor onboarding was also modernised. Instead of back and forth emails, suppliers now submit their information through a guided digital form that includes proof of bank details, streamlining vendor creation and reducing risk.

- Integration Services (ERP and finance system integration)

Cerebral Palsy Alliance implemented RapidP2P to modernise its accounts payable operations, simplify vendor onboarding and strengthen internal controls. Invoices are now captured, routed and approved through a centralised workflow, and new suppliers onboard themselves via secure self-service forms. With real-time visibility, the finance team has improved control and audit readiness across the entire process.

Outcomes Achieved

Cerebral Palsy Alliance now operates a streamlined and well-controlled accounts payable function. Invoices that once took a full day to process can now be handled in half the time, with far fewer delays or missed approvals.

Business managers find the system intuitive and quick to use, while the finance team benefits from real-time visibility, automated checks and full traceability. Vendor onboarding has also improved, with suppliers submitting accurate details through a guided process that removes back-and-forth communication.
